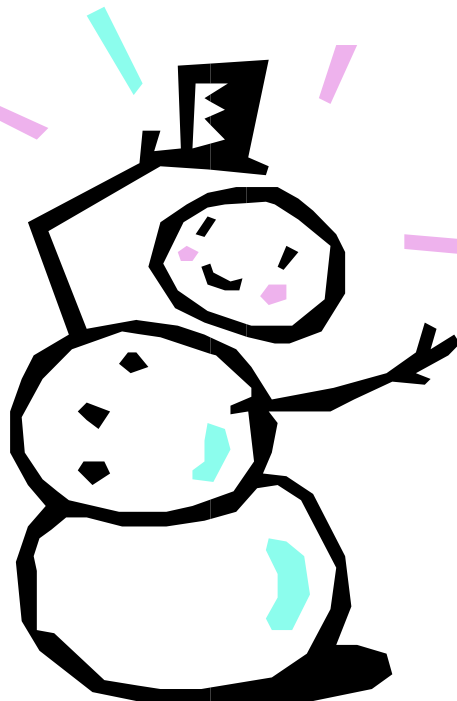
The True Meaning of the

Recipe of the month

Peanut Brittle

- 1 1/2 cup peanuts
- 1 cup white sugar
- 1/2 cup light corn syrup
- 1 pinch of salt
- 1 tablespoon of butter
- 1 teaspoon of vanilla
- 1 teaspoon of soda

Grease a baking sheet, and set aside. Cook in microwave for 6 to 7 min. Mixture should be bubbly and peanuts browned. Stir in butter and vanilla cook 2 to 3 minutes longer.

Quickly stir in baking soda, just until mixture is foamy. Pour immediately onto greased baking sheet. Let cool 15

Minutes or until set. Break into pieces, and store in an airtight container.
